INFORMATION FOR ALL STUDENTS

We are glad to have you here!
Here is what you need to know before starting.

Admin Needs

- Enrollment packet completed online, and emailed to office.
- Current Health Form aka: "School and Camp Form" emailed to office.
- Be sure to EMAIL the office a copy every time your child is seen for their physical/immunization visit.

Label Everything!

- One of the most important items to remember!
- Bottles, Lunch box, clothes, shoes, coats, etc. We want to make sure everything goes home with the right owner!
- Name Bubbles is great for labeling, and Inchbug has excellent water bottle bands.
- Please supply a Contigo Kids Water bottle, LABELED with quality name label or silicon nameband.
- Unlabeled bottles will incur a \$25 fee and two name bands will be ordered for you.

Drop Off Times

- Please drop off your child by 9:00 am, ready for the day (clean diaper, eaten breakfast.)
- Late drop offs are allowed for medical and educational appointments only. Students must arrive by 11:30 after these appointments.
- It is best to schedule appointments for the afternoon when possible to avoid disruption to your child's day.

Toileting

- All students: Bring a labeled pack of wipes for your cubby.
- Bring in a SMALL sleeve of diapers as needed. We will send a brightwheel message when supply is running low.
- At 2 years 6 months, we will begin offering the toilet to students who are not yet using the toilet already.

Extra Clothes

- Labeled weather appropriate clothes are stored at school in a shoebox size container.
- 2 shirts, 2 pants, 2 pairs of socks, 2 pairs of underwear.
- Soiled clothing will be sent home in a wet bag.
- Wet bags can be provided by you, or supplied by Little Lamb for \$7.
- When clothes are sent home, please return the wet bag & extra clothes the following school day.

Open House

- We will have an open house on Thursday, August 29 from noon to 1:30. Please come with your child to visit your child's classroom and meet their teachers!
- This is also a time to bring in extra clothes, diapers, wipes, etc.
- New families will receive your purchased supplies and door fobs, two per family. Please contact the office if you will need more than two fobs.

Meals : Toddler & PS

- Lunch should brought to school in a LABELED BentgoKids lunch box.
- We do not microwave foods, meals must be ready to eat.
- No glass jars, containers, bottles, etc are allowed at school.
- We are Peanut FREE School!
- We provide AM & PM snacks.
- Hot Lunch Desired? Inquire with the office about our hot lunch program.

Brightwheel

- Brightwheel is our communication system.
- Please be sure the brightwheel app is downloaded on to your phone.
- Preschool and Pre-K parents will receive photos, classroom info, and nap logs daily.
- Toddler parents will receive this info as well as meals, diaper and toilet logs.
- If your child is going to be absent, please send a morning message with the reason for the absence.
- Teachers reply during school hours only. Any messages sent after hours will be addressed the next school day.

Rest Time

- Todd & PS: A Rollee Pollee is required for rest time. It is an all in one sheet, blanket & pillow set.
- We provide a storage bag.
- \$25 will be charged to your account.
- Take home on Fridays to wash, or sooner if needed.
- Infants: See crib sheet info on Infant info form.

Home Toys

- We have a plethora of fun and engaging toys and activities at school, so please leave all toys at home or in the car for the ride home.
- A soft "lovie" can be used at rest time, and will be stored in the cubby during the remainder of the day.

The first day of school can feel scary for students and parents. We are prepared to support your family during this transition. A prolonged drop off makes it harder for children and adults. The best drop offs are with a hug, a kiss and a quick goodbye! We will send you a brightwheel update later in the morning!
